Things that we will be using during this workshop:

- magazines, old books and other found ephemera.
- Glue stick
- Sketchbook – mixed media or watercolor paper in a spiral sketchbook – approximately 6"x9" or 5.5"x8.5"
- brushes for glue and paint
- pencil
- 12" metal ruler
- scissors
- a couple of sheets of sandpaper – various
- watercolor paper, 140 lb hot or cold press
- a variety of writing/drawing utensils for mark-making – can include Sharpies, pencils, gel pens, or other markers – whatever you are comfortable with.
- Waxed paper.
- Baby wipes (small package).

Optional:

- Self-healing cutting mat
- Utility knife or
- various paints that may include but not limited to: gouache, watercolor, acrylic, watercolor pencils and other water soluble paints
- glazing fluid
- acrylic gloss medium
- tracing paper (9" x 12") and other paper including gridded and ruled paper or any other vintage paper
- hard rubber brayer (roller) or wallpaper seam roller
- colored and white tissue paper
- any other material that you may want to use.
- Mod Podge or other glues. I like Yes Paste, and a Permanent Archival Glue Stick. Feel free to use whatever glue that you feel comfortable using. I will give a brief overview of the options that you have.
